Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, services and equipment for the project entitled PHASE 1 CLEARING AND EARTHWORK FOR MIDAIR AVIATION FACILITY at Melbourne International Airport will be received by the CITY OF MELBOURNE AIRPORT AUTHORITY at the Office of the Executive Director, Melbourne International Airport, One Air Terminal Parkway, Suite 220, Melbourne, Florida 32901-1888 until **2:00 P.M., February 2, 2012**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

This project consists of clearing and grubbing approximately 10 acres of wooded area, excavating a pond, and using the excavated soil to fill an adjacent building and parking lot site.

Payment must be made by check or money order payable to the MELBOURNE AIRPORT AUTHORITY. Cash will not be accepted. The documents may also be obtained by prospective bidders as .pdf files on a CD at no charge. For instructions in how to receive the CD and to be placed on the planholders list to receive addenda, contact Jackie Thomas.

The site is in a public-access area (outside the airport security fence) and may be visited by prospective bidders at any time. No pre-bid conference is planned.

Bids (proposals) shall be submitted as set forth in the instructions included in the Contract Documents. The Melbourne Airport Authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any formalities or irregularities, or to re-advertise for bids.

To be eligible for award of contract, the successful bidder must submit, upon request and within five (5) business days after the bid opening, evidence of financial responsibility, experience, qualifications, and satisfactory completion of previous similar projects, to the satisfaction of the

Melbourne Airport Authority.

The Bidder agrees to comply with the following requirement: "No member, officer, or employee of the Melbourne Airport Authority or the City of Melbourne, during his or her tenure or for one year thereafter shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in this contract or the proceeds thereof".
